Begin by selecting the door style and profile that fits your home. Next, select the wood type that accentuates your style. We can also provide distressing to give the wood a more rustic look.














Finally select from the variety of accessories to complete your design. Hardware, glass, sidelights and transoms are some of the accessories to choose from.















# RAISED PANEL


**SHAKER, PLANK AND BARN  
DOOR STYLE**

Shaker style doors are primarily interior doors featuring a minimalist design with no decorative detail or profiling. This style can adapt flawlessly to a wide range of interior designs from contemporary to classic.

Plank doors may be similar to panel doors, but the panels are made of large vertical or diagonal slats. They can either be contemporary or rustic. Both the Plank and Shaker style doors work very well with Barn Doors.

# MODERN STYLE

Modern style doors are bold and innovative with clean lines and geometric shapes to give your home sophistication and style. Modern doors are typically a “flush” door with a veneer that can have grooves cut into the door to accentuate the modern look. 




